



STAN CALVERT RED HOT PROPERTY ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP 2018

In recognition of the significant contribution made by Stan Calvert towards the promotion and development of sport in Tynedale and in the Northern region, an Annual Scholarship, sponsored by Red Hot Property, has been inaugurated in both his honour and his memory. He was a man whose dedicated efforts were reflected in a positive commitment to sport in general and especially to sport enjoyed by young people. He succeeded admirably in combining this stimulating influence with an unflinching sense of fair play.

It is therefore entirely appropriate that this scholarship should be awarded in his name to a young person who has not only displayed excellence in his or her chosen sport, but who can also be encouraged to develop even further an outstanding potential. Whoever is successful will receive a grant of £600. The presentation will be made during the Sport Tynedale Annual Presentation of Awards.

A written application by the young person himself/herself, using the attached form, should be submitted to Sport Tynedale by Tuesday 30 October 2018.

The following criteria will apply.

The scholarship will be awarded annually to one young person. It is open to any individual sportsperson who will be aged eighteen or younger on the closing date for applications.

Applicants must have been permanently resident in the West Northumberland during the year prior to application. Their chosen sport must be recognised by Sport Tynedale.

Applicants must have participated in their nominated sport to at least County or an equivalent level during the year preceding application.

All applications must be accompanied at the time of submission by a supporting letter from an appropriate official of the relevant Governing Body of the sport in which at least County Honours, or equivalent, have been achieved. Should such a supporting letter not be received, then the application will not be considered.

Each applicant must specify in detail on the appropriate form how he or she would plan to use the award, with the grant having to be fully spent during the calendar year following the formal presentation of the scholarship. The young person who receives the award must report on such expenditure by the end of November of the year following the presentation.

The decision on the recipient of the award will be undertaken by the Awards Committee of Sport Tynedale.
