General Information:

- Those eligible for nominations are **individuals** residing in or playing/competing for a club/team based in West Northumberland which comprises of the former Tynedale District and Ponteland area.
- All sporting participation must be on an amateur basis.
- The awards recognise outstanding achievement, which could be for success at a highly competitive level or for significant improvements beyond previous levels of success. They may also acknowledge unusual initiatives and service to sport in the district by way of coaching or other relevant service.

- It is important that those who endorse a nomination should clearly state the level of achievement or contribution. **Where appropriate, this should include specific reference to the number of events/matches/games entered, the number of competitions participated in, the success achieved and contribution made.** The Awards Committee of Sport Tynedale can only consider information supplied in the nomination.

The Club of the Year Award (category 1) will go to the club with membership open to the public which has made a significant contribution to sport in the district, whether in a range of sports, or across varying age groups, or through a significant development.

The Team Awards (categories 2, 3, 4, 5, 6) are for club teams which must have membership open to the public, or schools, and have demonstrated outstanding achievement in their season.

Youth teams are under 18 age band on 31st August of this year.

The Young Volunteer of the Year (category 7) will be awarded to the young person up to 19 years old who has contributed to sport in their school and/or community, as a leader, coach or mentor. Particular consideration will be given to the lasting impact on other young people.

The Individual Awards (categories 8, 9, 10, 11, 12) are made to those who have achieved significant representative honours in one or more sports. The Disabled Sportsman will be of any age, Sportswoman and Sportsman will be 19 years old or over, while the Young Players will be 18 years old or younger on 31st August of this year.

The Sports Personality Awards (categories 13) will be given for very special contributions which have enhanced the representation of their sport, or made access and opportunity for participation more readily available, or in some way served as an example to others in the district

The Coach of the Year, (category 14) may be someone of any age, with a recognised coaching qualification. He or she will have made a significant contribution, on a voluntary basis, to the performance of coached individual(s) and/or team(s) from within the district.

The Services to Sport (Unsung Hero) (category 15) may be someone who is not at the front line of performance or coaching but whose contribution to a club or team has been invaluable.

The Tynedale Trophy (Snr) and the Ian Turner Trophy (Jnr) (category 16, 17) will be the final presentation of the evening. They will be chosen from the 16 award winners, so no specific nomination can be received. In coming to their decision on the recipient of this prestigious trophy, the Sport Tynedale Awards Committee will be seeking to recognise truly outstanding achievement and/or endeavour.

The Awards Committee will determine the recipients of trophies and certificates of merit and their decisions, made in good faith using the information provided by nominators, will be final.

All short listed and therefore potential award recipients will be invited by letter/email, to attend the Awards Evening.
